Have you had a Home Energy Check?

Before you start a project, you **must** complete a Home Energy Check to qualify for a home energy improvement rebate.

An exception will be made for emergency HVAC equipment installations and change-outs as a result of non-operating systems. However, a Home Energy Check must be completed prior to submitting an HVAC rebate. [Complete an online Home Energy Check in 5-10 mins now.](#)

1. **Recent Home Energy Check report** (within last 2 years)
An online assessment is available by visiting duke-energy.com/OnlineHEC
2. **AHRI reference number for the new system**
3. **Old system type**
4. **New system type**
5. **Contractor permit number / certificate**
6. **Itemized invoice must include the following**
 - a. Contractor Name & Address
 - b. Model #s Purchased/ Installed
 - c. Duke Account Holder Name & Address
 - d. Install Date
 - e. Total Install Cost Paid

***Quotes/Proposals are not acceptable**
